USERS

What are **some** of the users' goals for the website?

1. *Find information about their legal problem*
2. *Find attorney skilled in their legal problem*
3. *Find information about the firm generally*

What are three main user characteristics?

1. *Often non-experts, sometimes experts*
2. *Stressed and pressured about legal issue*
3. *Worried about finding right person, and worried about fees*

What is the expected level of user computer expertise?

Basic web surfing skills

Where will users be while using the website?

Home or office, maybe on mobile device

How robust will the internet connection be for most users?

Pretty good, on average

How important is it to support mobile users?

reasonably important

Do mobile users want to do different things than desktop users while on the site?

probably need contact information and location, but may want to read articles

TECHNICAL

What are **some** technical goals for the website?

1. *needs to work on phones, tablets, and desktops*
2. *smooth and competent - everything professional*
3. *no bad links, nothing broken*

Building only for modern web browsers is technically less complex, cheaper, and increases functionality. Even so, sometimes websites need to support users with older browsers.

Can the website require the use of a modern browser?

Yes. Our clients are mostly on modern browsers.

Is there an existing site which is to be expanded? If so, what languages and technologies does it use?

The current site has Flash sections. We'd like to move away from that. Rest of site is PHP.

Do you have an existing content management system (CMS)?

The current site was built in Drupal 6.0 and has not been upgraded.

Is the website database-driven? If so, which one?

It uses a MySQL server.

Do you have an existing web server?

It's hosted on Dreamhost.
